
We advocate economic, racial, social and environmental justice in Virginia's policies and practices through education, prayer and action.

Criminal Justice

Our faith traditions recognize that we all sin and transgress from both God's laws and human laws, and yet we believe in the fundamental power of forgiveness, redemption and restoration. VICPP seeks to reduce mass incarceration and stop the criminalization of poverty.



Immigrant Justice

VICPP is working to make Virginia a more equitable and welcoming place, with increased access to opportunities for all communities. As people of faith, we share the foundational values of loving our neighbors, caring for the vulnerable and uplifting marginalized members of our communities.
